

Export Notes

There is a default file named WMLEXP.CSV in the PCPICSW directory. This tells the system what fields to export and in which order. This is a comma-separated file. Below is a snapshot of the file as shown in Excel.

The system will export any fields listed here (for the listings that are currently in your listview) that have a number in columns I-O. The number in column I-O will be the position it is exported at. For Example the "Price" field as shown above will be in the 4th column of the exported data.

You can customize which fields are exported and the order in which they are exported by editing this file. Delete the line if you do not want to export the field.

The ONLY columns of data you will be changing is Columns I-O.

The columns I-O represent the categories. Column I is where the data will export for Category 1 (RES), J is for Category 2 etc... till O is for Category 7.

To add a field that is not listed here, you need to pull data from another csv file. Please make a copy of WML.CSV which is in the PCPICSW directory and work with the copy. If you change the original WML.CSV file your Virtual Office may not work.

Open the copy of the WML.CSV file you made and find the line that has the field information you need. Copy this and insert it into the WMLEXP.CSV file. Be sure to edit the columns I-O to reflect the order in which you want it to export.

NOTE: The numbering in columns I-O MUST be in order – no duplicate or holes in the numbers are allowed. You will get an error when you export if you do. Also, if you are going to be exporting multiple categories, you need export the same number of fields for each cat. You might have to add some "fake fields" (ones you do not really care about) to the categories so they match in the number of fields.

After you have edited the WMLEXP.CSV file, make sure you save it as a comma-separated text file in the PCPICSW directory.
